NAMEPLATES: For only **\$3** you can have your name stamped on a brass nameplate which is permanently affixed to the cover of your book. This personalizes your yearbook and also helps protect against theft. You can have a 1- or a 2-line name stamp. For example: Jennifer Smith, Class of 2010, or Jordan Daniels, Varsity Basketball Captain. You can purchase these optional nameplates during the advance sales period only.

Dear Parents of Seniors:

Here is important news about the award-winning Auburn High School Yearbook.

SENIOR “GRAD AD” PAGES:

Parents may purchase space in the 2009 – 2010 yearbook to include a special, personal message to your child. Ads will be printed in **FULL COLOR** but you can use either color or black and white pictures. (Pictures will be returned to you at the end of the year.) Ad prices are based on the following sizes:



Full Page	\$225
Half Page	\$150
1/4 Page	\$ 85

Keep in mind, you may not purchase a full page and then submit two, three or four separate ads. There are a limited number of pages set aside for senior ads so we recommend that if you are interested, purchase yours as soon as possible. You may pay for your ad during registration in the PAC on August 26 or at the bookkeeper’s window located by the attendance office. The last day to purchase your ad will be on December 11, 2009 (unless all space is sold prior to then).



At this time, all you need to do is pay. Don’t worry about completing your ad at this time! After your payment is received, you will be given a packet describing the exact size and options available for your ad space. Designing your ad is easy; you may want to look through previous year’s books for ideas and examples and begin gathering pictures you might like to use.

We will keep your ad a secret from your student so that it will be a surprise when the yearbooks come out in June, 2010. This is a very special graduation gift that creates a lasting memory for your son, daughter, or loved one.

SENIOR PORTRAITS:

The senior section of the yearbook is printed in color and most seniors use their picture taken at school for the yearbook. If you are having your child’s senior portraits taken early and would prefer this picture to be included in the yearbook, rather than their school picture, there are a few important deadlines and restrictions you need to be aware of:

1. Senior portraits must be submitted to Bob Horlick, Yearbook Adviser, at the address above, no later than November 13, 2009.
2. Portraits must be “school appropriate” and must adhere to the school dress code.
3. The background color of the picture must be a medium to dark blue gel with no visible pattern or design.
4. No hats or other props are to be in the photo; head and shoulders only.
5. The head size dimensions are ¾” wide by 1” high and print size dimensions are 1 ¾” wide by 2 ½” high (your photographer will know what this means).
6. Please share these specifications with your photographer to avoid problems later.
