The Peer Model Preschool Program is part of the Auburn School District Special Education Early Childhood program which serves preschool children with developmental delays. We are excited to offer openings for children without developmental delays, 3 to 5 years old to participate in an enriched learning environment focused on developing communication and language, social, self-help, motor and school (cognitive) skills. Peer models also learn leadership and helping skills by modeling appropriate play and communication for their classmates with developmental delays.

Parents must provide transportation

- Length of Program: 2 1/2 hours per day. M-TH, AM and PM sessions available
Age of children: 3 to 5 year olds. Children must be 3 by Sept. 1.
Cost: \$135.00 per mo. or \$110.00 per mo. when parent volunteers 10 hours per mo. to the program
