We hope you have been enjoying the nice spring weather! The following information is intended to help you be more aware of what is happening at school and better able to partner with us.

Visitors and Campus Security

You may have noticed new signs on each of our exterior doors. These signs are intended to better communicate our procedure for anyone who is visiting our school. All visitors must enter through the main office entrance (by the flagpole) and check in at the main office before going anywhere in the school or playground. We allow parents to walk their children to class before for school starts, but, after 8:40 a.m., visitors should not go to classrooms without checking in at the main office first. If you are going to be visiting a classroom or volunteering elsewhere on campus during the school day, you will be asked to sign in and wear a visitor's badge. Please always be prepared to show ID, especially if you are picking up a student, in case the office staff needs verification. Although these procedures can seem to be a nuisance at times, they are important to ensure security at our school, and we greatly appreciate your cooperation.

Lost and Found

The lost and found is overflowing. We are laying the lost and found items out in the main hallway so that students can more easily find missing items. If you're at the school, please come take a look to see if you can identify lost items. If not picked up before spring break, the items will be donated.

State Standardized Testing

Kindergarten Roundup

If you have a child who will start kindergarten next year, please mark your calendar for kindergarten roundup on Tuesday, May 3rd from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. and kindergarten screening on Friday, May 6th sometime during the school day. We are currently open for kindergarten registration, and we encourage you to register as soon as possible rather than wait for roundup or summer. If you register at one school and then move, you can change your registration to your new school. Please share this information with anyone else you know who will have a kindergartener next year.

Students who need extra support with learning can benefit greatly from extra practice under the guidance of an adult.
