Forms are available in the office Birth certificate and current immunizations are required.



Early literacy and math skills are emphasized and align with kindergarten curriculum. Peer models also learn leadership and helping skills appropriate by modelina plav and communication for their classmates with developmental delays. The cost is \$150 per month.
