PLANS FOR 2015-16

Lea Hill is in year two of a three-year school improvement plan. Our Building Leadership Team works with our faculty and staff to monitor school improvement goals and action steps that will help all of our students experience success. This process looks at current and historical data, identifying strengths and challenges. Our team collected input from staff, students and families. Adjustments are made to our school improvement plan as needed. Our plan also incorporates the new technology from the recently approved Technology Levy. Lea Hill is also in year two of implementing Second Step as our Social Emotional Learning and Anti-Bullying curriculum (grades preschool through fifth). This research-based curriculum teaches students skills in recognizing and managing emotions, having empathy, controlling impulses, communicating clearly, cooperation, responsibility and problem solving.

HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR SCHOOL

- Lea Hill has a real-world diversity. We are always one of the top schools in Auburn for total number of languages spoken. Our ELL program is outstanding.
- Lea Hill is an award-winning Green School and has a courtyard filled with fruit and vegetable gardens.
- Lea Hill received a grant from King County to help us purchase a brand new \$80,000 play structure for our playground.
- Lea Hill has a Nature Trail on the back side of our campus for outdoor learning.
- Lea Hill proudly houses the district elementary level Pathways behavior program. Our students in this program are extremely successful.
- Lea Hill celebrated it's 50th anniversary (1965 to 2015) in June of 2015.
- Lea Hill has more preschool classrooms than any school in Auburn (three ECE and one Headstart).

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Lea Hill utilizes staff and parent volunteers after school to offer the only robotics program at the elementary school level. We partner with AMHS for robotics support.
- Lea Hill has a long and proud history of community support, including a PTA that raises thousands of dollars a year for our students and staff.
- Lea Hill ASB offers monthly family nights in the gym.
- Lea Hill has supportive volunteers that regularly come in and work with our students and staff.
- School Board Gold Star Volunteer recognition for a Lea Hill community member who maintains our gardens and teaches our students about growing plants for healthy eating.
- Local church helps support some of our needy families with weekly food donations.

LAP PROGRAM

Lea Hill is a Learning Assistance Program (LAP) school. LAP programs serve eligible students who need academic support for reading, writing and math, or who need readiness skills to learn these core subjects. With special emphasis on reading literacy in grades K-4, schools use their state LAP funds to deliver supplemental services that give these students the strong start they need for academic success.

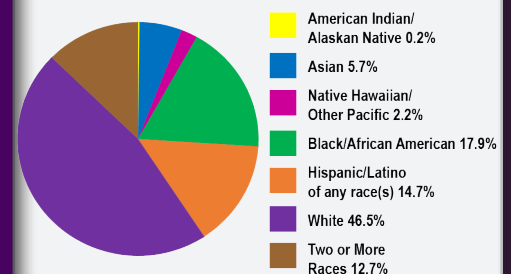

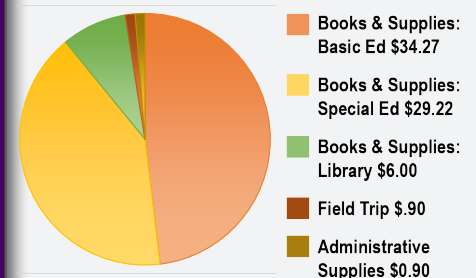

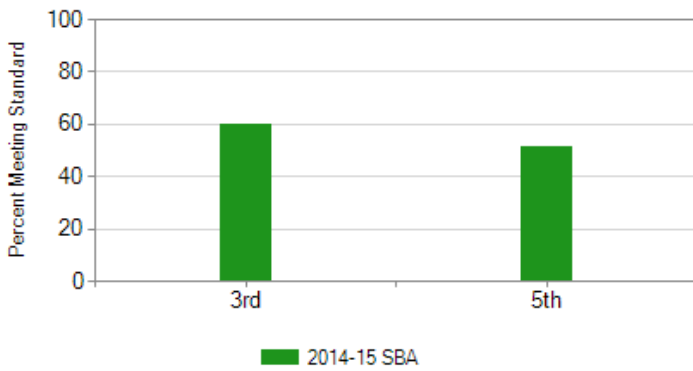


LEA HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL 2014-15 BUDGET Funds Spent Per Student (not including salary)

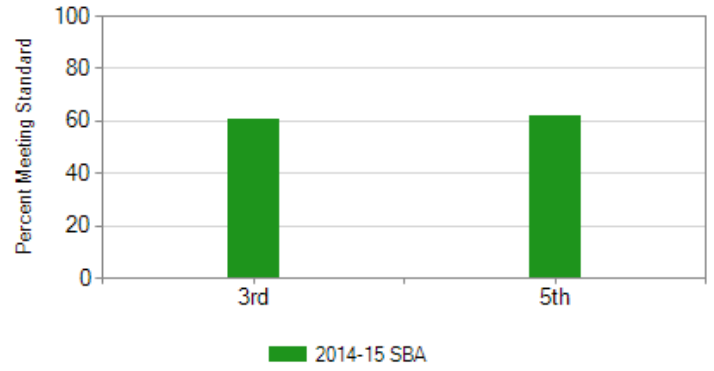
