# **PLANS FOR 2016-17**

Instructional plans for the 2016-17 year are based on student performance from formative and summative assessments which include DIBELS, MAPS, SBA and all classroombased assessments. Students receive targeted guidance and feedback during repeated oral reading to increase fluency. Reading comprehension instruction, particularly of informational text, is an area of emphasis. Math specialist provides instruction in K-2 classrooms while the classroom teachers in grades 3-5 are responsible for math instruction using Engage New York Math. Teachers are implementing all components of the Common Core State Standards in Mathematics, English Language Arts and Next Generation Science Standards. Students use technology to support their individual learning needs with the use of Chromebooks and classroom computers. Science instruction occurs at all grade levels with a focus on the vocabulary of science and the scientific process.

### **HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR SCHOOL**

There are many programs and activities at Hazelwood Elementary School that serve to enrich, extend and recognize the talents of the students. One program that gives students first-hand experience in community service is the Student Jobs Program. Students take responsibility for various jobs at school such as changing the reader board, hosting assemblies and emptying recycle bins. A student from each class is also selected for outstanding classroom behavior as the Citizen-of-the-Month and has lunch with the principal. Our Perfect Attendance Program recognizes classes as well as individual students monthly, who have perfect attendance. The Hazelwood Elementary School PTA oversees the Accelerated Reader Program that supports student reading and comprehension. AR Celebrations are held six times a year for those students who reach their reading level goal in the Accelerated Reader program.

A well-rounded school experience is important to Hazelwood with students having the opportunity to participate in basketball, Chess Club, Science Club, music performance for different grade level events and community service projects such as the Auburn Food Drive.

### **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

The Hazelwood Elementary School community of parents, students and teachers recognize education as a common goal. Parents spend countless hours volunteering their time and expertise in the classrooms, around the building and within their homes. Parents also contribute meaningful insights to the building and district committees on which they serve. Hazelwood Elementary School's PTA has achieved phenomenal success in generating funds to enrich Hazelwood Elementary School's program and enhance staff efforts through a yearly Walk-a-Thon. Many PTA programs support students including Citizen-of-the-Month lunches, field trips, assemblies and grants for teachers. Hazelwood students are the MVPs of the school community. They are hard- working, respectful and creative young people. Hazelwood students exhibit school pride, a high level of participation and a genuine eagerness to learn. Families are encouraged to participate in lunch and recess with their child and to attend our family events such as Movie Night, Skate Nights, Music Performances, and special grade-level programs.

## LAP PROGRAM

Hazelwood is a Learning Assistance Program (LAP) school. LAP programs serve eligible students who need academic support for reading, writing and math, or who need readiness skills to learn these core subjects. With special emphasis on reading literacy in grades K-5, schools use their state LAP funds to deliver supplemental services that give these students the strong start they need for academic success.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS - Grades 3, 4 & 5




MATH - Grades 3, 4 & 5






**OUR STUDENT COMMUNITY AT HAZELWOOD**
