

## High-Frequency Words: Kindergarten

High-frequency words are introduced in each theme with a literature selection. These words are research-based and are often found on the Dolch, Fry, or Harris-Jacobson Word Lists. These words are tested in *Trophies*. *High-Frequency Word Cards* are recommended to be used as a teaching tool during the lessons. High-frequency word lessons appear on the 5-day planners and are easy to identify in the “Learning to Read” part of the lesson plan. The high-frequency words are also referenced by theme and by story in the back of the *Teacher’s Edition*.
