

Vocabulary Words: Grade 3

Vocabulary words begin to appear in the 1-4 book at Grade 1 and continue through Grade 6. Vocabulary lessons appear in the *Pupil Edition* and present the vocabulary for the selection in context. To answer the need for additional vocabulary instruction, vocabulary activities are added in the *Pupil Edition* beginning in Grade 2. Every selection, beginning with the 1-4 book, begins with a list of vocabulary words.

Each word is defined at point-of-use in the *Teacher's Edition*, and a teaching transparency is provided for the teacher to introduce students to these words in context. A vocabulary-writing connection also includes an opportunity for students to develop more knowledge of vocabulary in *Trophies*.
