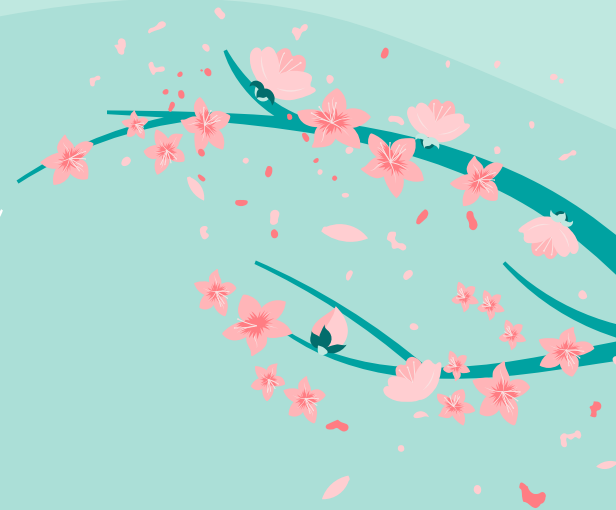

Title I & LAP Funded Extended Learning

Ensuring extended learning opportunities for students at-risk is supported in District Strategic Plan 2017-2022 stating, “We believe each child can learn at high levels and each staff member has a responsibility to make this a reality.”

During the 24/25 school year Auburn has the unique opportunity to leverage Title I, LAP, and LAP HP funding for planning and implementing activities related to supplemental afterschool programs, including addressing the needs of low-income students, students with disabilities, English learners, migrant students, students experiencing homelessness, and children in foster care.

Funding per school:

- *\$15,000 Title I, LAP, or LAP HP Funds*
- *\$500 from Basic Ed for snacks*

Program Focus:

- *Math, ELA , Credit Recapture and Recovery first*
- *Enhancements include science, the arts,*
- *Other content areas supporting identified student needs and/or interest.*

Course Rosters & Attendance (T, P, A, R)

In order to have programs approved, schools must have a **minimum of 15 students in a grade level**. Sections should not exceed 25 students. Each section must have one certificated staff member operating as lead teacher, and organizer. A wait list should be maintained for numbers in excess of **25** at each grade. A second section within a grade level may be approved once the total count of eligible students reaches 40.

Teacher Responsibilities

- Get roster from coordinator
- Planning: Communicate with original teacher to establish skills required
- Send a reminder to students before beginning the program (suggestion- place them in a RECAP classroom or REMIND app to streamline communication)
- Walk students to the FRONT of the building for parent pick-up or bus
- ~~Send home Student Parent Compact/Student Learning Plan (Track returns with at least 3 attempts made.)~~ This is already part of registration materials
- Complete compliance documents provided by the Coordinator (Attendance, Lesson Plans, Pre/post results)
- Send home Student Progress Report at the end of program or end of trimester. ([Student Learning Plan with updated scores](#))- 3 points of contact home
- Give Student Records to the Coordinator (Communications, Invitations, School Parent Compact/Students Learning Plans with tracking, Assessments used for Progress Monitoring, Completed Progress Report [Extended Learning Student Records - Google Docs](#)
