Athletic Physicals.

Information on Sports Physicals and Athletic Participation Paperwork.

Athletic physicals may be good for two consecutive years. If you are an incoming 6th grader, you must get a physical after July 1, 2016 to participate in Olympic athletics. (Available in the ASB office and online on the District Webpage under athletic information/athletics & activities).

Anyone who is currently attending Olympic Middle School (7th or 8th grade) and has a physical on file and signed by their physician after July 1, 2015 it will be good for one additional year.

All athletes participating in sports during the 2016-2017 school year must complete **new** Participation Paperwork, Concussion, Sports Informed Consent, and Sudden Cardiac Arrest forms, complete with parent signatures and insurance information, and purchase ASB **before turning out for the first practice of the season**.
