U: Stands for scholarships open to undocumented students

Starting October 1st, all seniors should go to <u>https://fafsa.gov</u>/ and complete their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Washington State Scholarship Programs:

- <u>The Washington State Opportunity</u> <u>Scholarship (WSOS)</u> supports low- and middle-income students pursuing eligible high-demand majors in science, technology, engineering, math (STEM) or health care.
- <u>Act Six Scholarship</u>: Act Six is a leadership and full-tuition scholarship program that connects local faith-based community affiliates with faith- and social justice-based colleges
- <u>Governor's Scholarship:</u> The Washington State Governor's Scholarship for Foster Youth is a scholarship program that helps students in/from foster care continue their education and earn a college degree. Deadline: January 31, 2021
- Leadership 1000 Scholarship: The Leadership 1000 scholarship is for students attending a four-year college or university in Washington state and have at least a 2.75 high school GPA. Deadline: February 12, 2021
- Washington State Scholarships for <u>Undocumented Students:</u> This scholarship list is for scholarships

specifically for students who are undocumented.

253 PLU Bound Full Tuition Scholarship - Rolling Application

PLU offers a scholarship for students who are College Bound eligible, attend a high school in Washington state, and have a 3.50 or better weighted cumulative GPA. Students who qualify will be awarded full tuition for their four years at PLU through a combination of federal, state, PLU grants and scholarships, and the College Bound Scholarship.

CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Sallie Mae fund Bridging the Dream Scholarship - Deadline March 8, 2021

The Sallie Mae Fund's Bridging the Dream Scholarship Program for High School Seniors helps make the dream of higher education a reality for outstanding students from minority and other historically underserved communities. High school seniors who are facing financial challenges may apply to win a \$10,000 scholarship to help them attend college or a vocational-technical school.

Ewing C. Kelly Scholarship - Deadline March 10, 2021

The Kelly Foundation of Washington is pleased to offer the *Ewing C. Kelly Scholarship*. High school seniors in the state of Washington are eligible. Applicants will be judged on citizenship, academic achievement, and financial need. Each award is worth \$2,500 and winners will be notified in April. All applications (with ALL attachments) must be postmarked by March 10, 2021. (*Late or incomplete applications will not be judged*).

Seattle Hiroshima Club Scholarship - Deadline March 13, 2021

Scholarships will be awarded to qualified High School seniors who plan to pursue their higher education beginning the fall of 2021. Any high school senior, whose parent or grandparent is a current paid member for the 2020 year or a paid member for the 2021 year before March 13, 2021, and who meets the other eligibility requirements as stated in the cover letter of the application will be considered for the award. Beyond the Boroughs National Scholarship - Deadline March 15, 2021

Since 2007, Beyond the Boroughs has been bringing bright futures to those deserving young men and women that have been accepted into college, but have unmet financial need, by helping pay the exorbitant cost of a higher education.

Founded by NFL veteran Tutan Reyes, whose life was transformed by the college scholarship he received, Beyond the Boroughs awards four-year scholarships -- each worth up to \$20,000 – to both male and female students of any race from any state. We aim to create deserved college scholarship opportunities for students, with a primary focus on first generation collegians.

The Kim and Harold Louie Family Foundation Scholarship - Deadline

March 15, 2021

This scholarship is for high school seniors and students who will be attending a college or university in the United States as a freshman during the 2021-2022 academic year. Applicants who are currently not seniors in high school (e.g., students who are taking a gap year or adults returning to school), but applicants who will be considered incoming freshmen are eligible to apply. Applicants should have demonstrated outstanding personal achievements, academic merit, leadership qualities and/or community service. Special consideration will be noted for applicants:

* who have **parents** that are United States veterans or are currently in the U.S. military;

* with a demonstrated financial need; or

* with parents who did not attend college.

KFC REACH Educational Grant Program - Deadline March 25, 2021

The REACH Educational Grant Program[®] helps employees at participating KFC U.S. restaurants pursue their dreams of going to college. Employees of any age, any position, pursuing any degree can receive money to help them attend the accredited four-year or two-year college of their choice. The money can also be used at trade/vocational schools and for graduate study.

FEEA Scholarships - Deadline March 26, 2021

Scholarship Awards: Scholarships range between \$1,000 and \$7,500 for one year of academic study at an accredited college or university. The scholarship is not renewable,

however, applicants may apply every year they are eligible, whether or not they have received an award in the past. Individuals Eligible for Scholarships:

a. Children or legal dependents under the age of 25 of full- or part-time permanent federal civilian or postal employees. Blacks in Government (BIG) federal employee members may also sponsor a grandchild.

b. Spouses of full- or part-time permanent civilian federal or postal employees.

c. Full- or part-time permanent civilian federal or postal employees.

d. Children or grandchildren of members of the National Active and Retired Federal Employees Association (NARFE).

Boule Foundation Scholarship - Deadline March 29, 2021

The Boule' Foundation in conjunction with the United Negro College Fund will provide annual \$4,000 **merit-based** scholarships to entering college freshmen students (fall 2021) of African descent attending four-year, accredited, non-profit degree-granting colleges and universities of their choice.

Applicants for the program must meet the following criteria:

- Possess a minimum cumulative GPA of a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale;
- Be of African descent;

BAM (Blacks at Microsoft) Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021 This year, BAM will award two US \$5,000 scholarships to outstanding high school seniors who are interested in pursuing careers in technology. The scholarships are renewable – winners who continue to meet the criteria can receive an annual \$5,000 award for up to four years. Five scholarship runners-up will be eligible for a \$1,500 BAM technology stipend based on need.

2021 Lotus Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021

Guided by the belief that immigrant students are deserving of respect and support, the Foundation's Lotus Scholarship Program provides assistance to recently immigrated students in Washington's King, Pierce and Snohomish counties. The purpose of the scholarship program is to give financial support to immigrant and refugee students who are pursuing post-secondary education, regardless of the students' immigration status. All application information is kept strictly confidential. NC Scholarships - Deadline March 31, 2021

The \$2,000 Nitro Scholarship Sweepstakes is only open to legal residents of the 50 United States, the District of Columbia, age 17 or older at the time of entry, and who meet one (1) of the five (5) following eligibility requirements at the time of entry:

- 1. a parent who currently has a child enrolled in an accredited college or university located within the United States;
- 2. a student who is currently enrolled in an accredited college or university located within the United States;
- 3. a parent who currently has a child enrolled as a high school senior located within the United States;
- 4. a student who is currently enrolled as a high school senior located with the United States;
- a student or a parent whose child has graduated from an accredited undergraduate school (a "School) and who is currently paying back a student or parent loan for his/her/child's educational expenses for such School ("Entrant").

Nora Stone Smith Scholarship for ESL and ELL Students - Deadline March 31, 2021

- Renewable \$1,000 \$2,000 scholarship.
- This scholarship is available for all ESL/ELL students, regardless of their citizenship status.
- Open to students who are graduating seniors, college freshmen, or those graduated with a high school diploma.
- Supports Private 4-year University or College, Public 4-year University or College, Public 2-year Community / Technical College.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

University of the Aftermarket Foundation Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021

Since its inception, the University of the Aftermarket Foundation has awarded millions of dollars of scholarships. In 2020 alone, 461 scholarships were awarded totaling \$644,500. While the foundation has realized consistent growth, it has experienced even

greater progress with the formation of committees to address marketing, scholarships, grants and contributions.

Who Qualifies for this Scholarship?

- Full time students at an accredited U.S. college or university or an ASE/NATEF Certified post-secondary automotive, heavy duty, or collision repair school
- Graduating high school seniors planning to be full time students at any of the above
- No GPA requirement

Beyond the Cure Ambassador Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021

The Beyond the Cure Ambassador Scholarship Program awards college scholarships to childhood cancer survivors who have demonstrated the ability to overcome the difficult challenges of cancer with determination and motivation. Fifty-eight college scholarships are awarded each year.

Harvard Business Services Entrepreneur Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021

The Harvard Business Services business scholarship program was created to help ambitious students chase their dreams by providing a \$1,000 award. In 2021, we will award two \$1,000 scholarships for business majors and entrepreneurs — one to a student with a for-profit business concept and the other to a non-profit concept.

Outstanding Junior Masonic Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2021

Washington Masonic Charities is proud to partner with the Grand Lodge of Washington to offer scholarships for deserving young people throughout the state of Washington. Masons believe strongly in investing in the education of young people - tens of thousands of dollars a year in scholarships are provided to youth by Masonic Lodges across the state.

VFW Auxillary's Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest -

Deadline March 31, 2021

Each year, more than 4,000 high school students from across the country participate in the VFW Auxiliary's Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest. The first-place winner from each state competes for national awards totaling \$31,500.

College Board Opportunity Scholarships - Deadlines vary through Mar 2021

The College Board Opportunity Scholarships program is **now available for all juniors**. Since 2018, nearly one million students have joined this program, which provides students with a digital college planning guide and chances to earn \$500 for each action they finish. When students complete all six steps, they earn a chance at a <u>\$40,000</u> scholarship. Students whose families earn less than \$60,000 per year have double the chances to earn scholarships. In total, almost \$5 million in scholarships are awarded each year, nationwide. High school juniors can visit <u>cb.org/opportunity</u> to join. <u>The earlier juniors get started</u>, the more opportunities they'll have to earn scholarships! Between January and March, the College Board will award \$500 scholarships to 3,000 juniors who build a college list or practice for the SAT. All students can earn one of these scholarships, even those who never dreamt they could get a scholarship.

Lockheed Martin STEM Scholarship - Deadline April 1, 2021

Each year, the STEM Scholarship Program awards \$10,000 to 200 recipients studying engineering or computer science at a 4-year college or university. Recipients may renew the scholarship up to three times for a total potential value of \$40,000 per student.

Heavy Equipment Parts Express Scholarship - Deadline April 1, 2021

Every year HE Parts Express offers a \$500 scholarship to students. To be eligible to apply, please read the eligibility guidelines, then submit an application along with the essay.

Cathay Bank Foundation Scholarship - Deadline April 2, 2021

Twenty \$1,000 scholarships available for high school seniors planning to attend college as a full-time, degree-seeking student beginning the fall of 2021. Click on the name of the scholarship to find out eligibility requirements.

Kao Kalia Yang Scholarship - Deadline April 2, 2021

Five \$5,000 Renewable Scholarships Available for High School Seniors Planning to Attend College as a Full-Time, Degree-Seeking Student in the Fall of 2021. The Robin-Hwajin Yoon Kim Foundation, which supports education, the underprivileged, and positive social impact initiatives has established the "Kao Kalia Yang Scholarship" to help economically-challenged Hmong American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education.

The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund - Deadline April 2, 2021

10 – \$5,000 Scholarships for High School Seniors and 1st Year College Students Planning to Attend a University/College in the U.S. in the Fall of 2021. The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund is focused on helping economicallychallenged Taiwanese American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education.

KhSA Scholarship 2021 - Deadline April 4, 2021

Khmer Americans are among the **least represented within colleges nationwide**. We established this scholarship in 2015 to address the educational achievement gap existing in our community. KhSA's mission this year is to help unite our community and empower our youth. As Khmer students attending university now, we want to aid young Khmer Americans in their pursuit of higher education.

This year we will be awarding two \$1000 scholarships to high school seniors in Washington state.

Scott Banke Memorial Scholarships - Deadline Extended from Apr 11th to May 9, 2021

The Purpose of this Scholarship is to promote a positive impact in our Community and World ... Making Impact-Makers.

Six (6) **\$2,000** Scholarships will be awarded in Auburn, Washington.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Academics Performs well academically and has clear plans for continuing education
- Character Exemplify kindness and compassion for others
- Leadership Exhibits leadership skills
- **Service** Demonstrates commitment to community service

Association of Computer Professionals in Education Scholarship -Deadline April 15, 2021

The Association of Computer Professionals in Education (ACPE) has allocated up to \$10,000 for scholarships of up to \$2,000 each for students in Oregon and Washington. These scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors who have been actively involved in the innovative use of technology during their high school careers and are planning to pursue studies in a technology-related field.

Don Barrows Memorial Scholarship - Deadline April 15, 2021

The <u>Federal Way Chorale</u> is offering to locally based high school seniors the opportunity to apply for the Don Barrows Memorial Scholarship. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior from the Federal Way or the surrounding area and planning a collegiate major or minor in vocal music, music education or musical theatre. A two thousand dollar award (\$2,000) will be granted to the winner. Please plan ahead, since the application needs to be mailed in.

Intertech Foundation STEM Scholarship - Deadline April 15, 2021

Intertech STEM scholarships are non-renewable, and are awarded for one year to a scholarship recipient in the amount of \$2500 to a college-bound high school graduating applicant, starting higher education in the fall of the same year.

To be eligible, the student must possess:

- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.3 or higher
- An intent to study computer science
- Graduating high school in the spring of 2021 and enrolling at or accepted to an accredited college or university within the US by the end of August, 2021

National Dairy Shrine Scholarships - Deadline April 15, 2021

All National Dairy Shrine scholarships and student awards are only for U.S. students attending schools, colleges or universities in the United States and majoring in dairy or other agricultural related fields.

NDTA Scholarship Program - Deadline April 15, 2022

To provide college scholarship opportunities for NDTA members and their dependents; to encourage high school graduates to consider academic pursuit of degrees in the fields of logistics, transportation, supply chain, physical distribution, and passenger travel services.

Scott & Kim Verplank Foundation Scholarship - Deadline April 30, 2022

The Scott and Kim Verplank Foundation provides annually, renewable college scholarships to students beginning their undergraduate studies of up to \$10,000 to be used toward tuition, student fees, and books. Recipients are selected from a pool of applicants meeting the following criteria.

Minimum Criteria

- High School Senior
- <u>Childhood diagnosis of Type 1 Diabetes</u>
- Successfully managing diabetes with proper medication, exercise and diet

- Commitment to education by maintaining in excess of a 3.0 grade point average
- Commitment to participating in athletics by actively participating on an organized team
- United States Citizen
- Completion of application with supporting documentation and endorsements

Porch Skilled Trade and Technology Scholarship - Deadline March 31, 2022

Growing demand and lack of qualified workers in skilled trades and technology means it's a great time to go back to school and enter these lucrative and fast-growing industries. To help keep up with demand and assist the next generation of professionals, Porch will award a \$2,000 scholarship four times a year to eligible students.

Washington Pointe Pest Control Scholarship - Deadline April 29, 2022

For this scholarship, do something good for someone else and include a note telling them to pass it on. Bonus points are awarded for including pictures. We want to hear what good deed you did to help your community. After you have finished your good deed, pass along this scholarship to as many friends as you can. For every submission we get that says you referred/told them about this scholarship, you get bonus points. Once your good deed is finished and you have told all of your friends about this scholarship, play the Pointe Pest Control game and take a screenshot of your highest score. Bonus points are added to your application for playing the game.

- Applications for the scholarship can be submitted by any high school senior or college freshman from the state of Washington.
- This scholarship is a one-time scholarship worth \$750.

Green River College Scholarship - Deadline April 30, 2022

The applicant must be a full-time student who is majoring (either accepted or currently enrolled) in an Engineering discipline within an accredited college or university in Western Washington. The Edmund F. Maxwell Foundation Scholarship - Deadline April 29, 2022

The Edmund F. Maxwell Foundation scholarship is offering high-achieving students financial aid of up to \$5,000 (renewable for up to four years) who plan on attending a **private college**.

Qualifying students will have spent at least the last two years at a high school and lived in a city west of the Cascade Mountains. Students will also have demonstrated financial need (as determined by the college that the student is planning to attend)

Due to COVID 19 restrictions, we have waived our SAT/ACT requirement, but if a student has been able to take the test, we encourage reporting of those scores on the application.

Application due date: April 30, 2021

Additional materials due date: May 14, 2021

(Additional materials include a high school transcript and a completed Financial Aid Worksheet from the students potential PRIVATE colleges)

Paradigm Challenge Competition - Deadline May 1, 2022

The Paradigm Challenge is an ongoing competition that invites students aged 4 to 18 around the world to use kindness, creativity, and collaboration to help solve real-life problems and make a difference. All it takes is one idea. Use your creativity to win up to \$100,000 and change the world. The students who submit the top idea in each age division (4-8, 9-13, and 14-18) will attend the Ceremony and compete for The Paradigm Challenge Prize! They welcome all types of ideas, including posters, videos, inventions, public messages, community events, websites, mobile apps, or anything else that will help address one or more of the Paradigm Challenge Projects.

Code Wizards HQ Educational Scholarship - Deadline May 1, 2022

Once a year, a high school senior or incoming college freshman will receive \$2500 to support their education. At CodeWizardsHQ we believe that the future is built on diversity through equity and access. While we actively work toward implementing hiring practices that are geared toward diversifying our team, we also understand that having access to higher education is a means to broadening a diverse candidate pool for the future STEM workforce.

PHCC Educational Foundation Scholarships - Deadline May 1, 2022

The PHCC Educational Foundation and its industry partners are teaming up to provide financial assistance to students pursuing a career in the p-h-c industry. The Foundation Scholarship Committee approved these new adjustments to the scholarship program. – Plumbing and HVAC apprentices may use scholarship funds toward their required apprenticeship program textbook expenses (does *not* apply to college or trade schools). – Scholarships may be used toward the PHCC Educational Foundation's online apprenticeship training program or *Fast Track to Service Plumbing* course. The apprentice or technician must be employed by a PHCC–National Association contractor member company.

For the 2021 scholarship program only:

 An applicant who has previously won a Foundation scholarship may apply for another scholarship in 2021, as long as they continue to meet all other eligibility requirements.
Past winners who have been awarded more than one past scholarship may apply, but a small deductive score modifier will be applied.

AND

 Apprentices working part-time (not just full-time) for a PHCC member company may also apply for the Foundation scholarships.

RushOrdersTees Young Entrepreneurs Scholarship - May 1, 2022

The scholarship is available to undergraduate students and high school seniors planning to attend college the following year. We're looking for entrepreneurs, builders, and creators. You'll be asked to submit a short essay on why you're interested in entrepreneurship and how you believe you can contribute to our society through your entrepreneurial vision. The UW Paul R. Wineman Scholarship - Deadline May 1, 2022

Applicants must be a freshman male student at <u>The University of Washington</u> beginning in the Fall of 2021. Selection will be merit-based. An ideal applicant to this scholarship is a passionate leader that exemplifies excellence in their community and high school. By applying for this scholarship, you are not committing yourself to membership in Phi Kappa Psi or any other organization. One \$1000.00 scholarship, and at least four \$500.00 scholarships, will be awarded in the summer of 2021, prior to the beginning to the Fall term at The University of Washington.

Thermo Fisher Scientific Antibody Scholarship - Deadline May 4, 2022

The Program is open only to graduate and undergraduate students who (i) will be attending an accredited US college or university in the Fall 2021 semester; (ii) who is or will be a legal resident of one of the 50 US states or the District of Columbia as of August 5, 2021; (iii) will be at least 18 years of age or older as of August 5, 2021; and (iv) have a declared major of biology, chemistry, bio-chemistry or a related life science field; and (v) meets the following applicable GPA requirements:

- Graduate students must have a cumulative graduate GPA of >3.0 on a 4.0 scale, and have received a cumulative undergraduate GPA of >3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Undergraduate Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors must have cumulative college GPA of >3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Undergraduate Freshmen must have a cumulative high school GPA of >3.0 on a 4.0 scale

One recipient will receive a \$10,000 scholarship and five recipients will each receive a \$5,000 scholarship. All scholarship award payments will be made directly to the college or university at which the recipient is enrolled.
