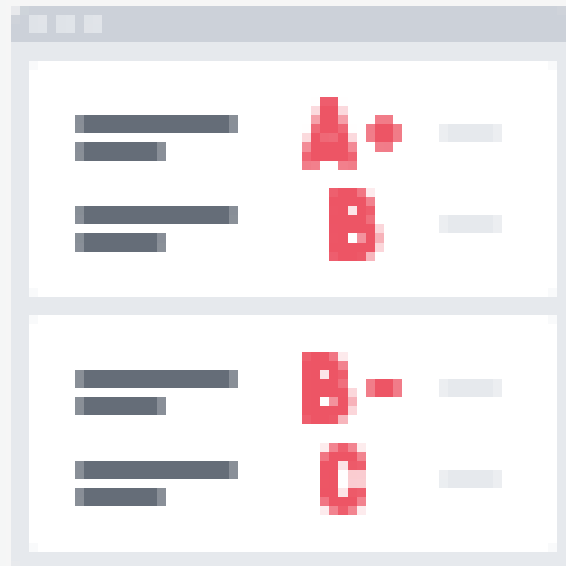

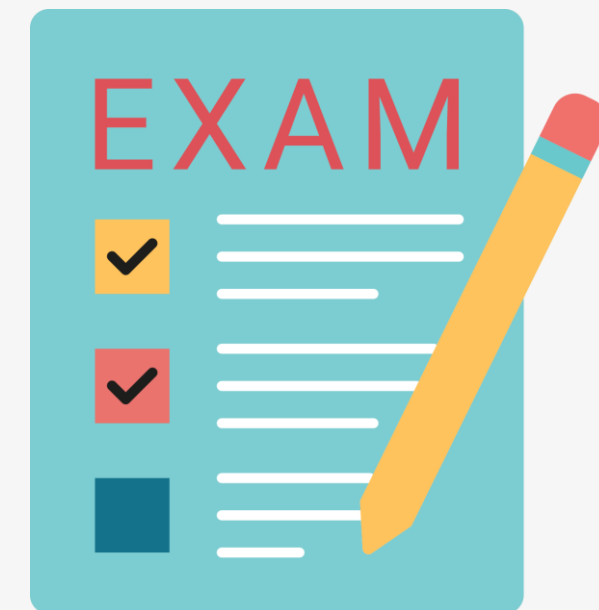

Advice from Counselors

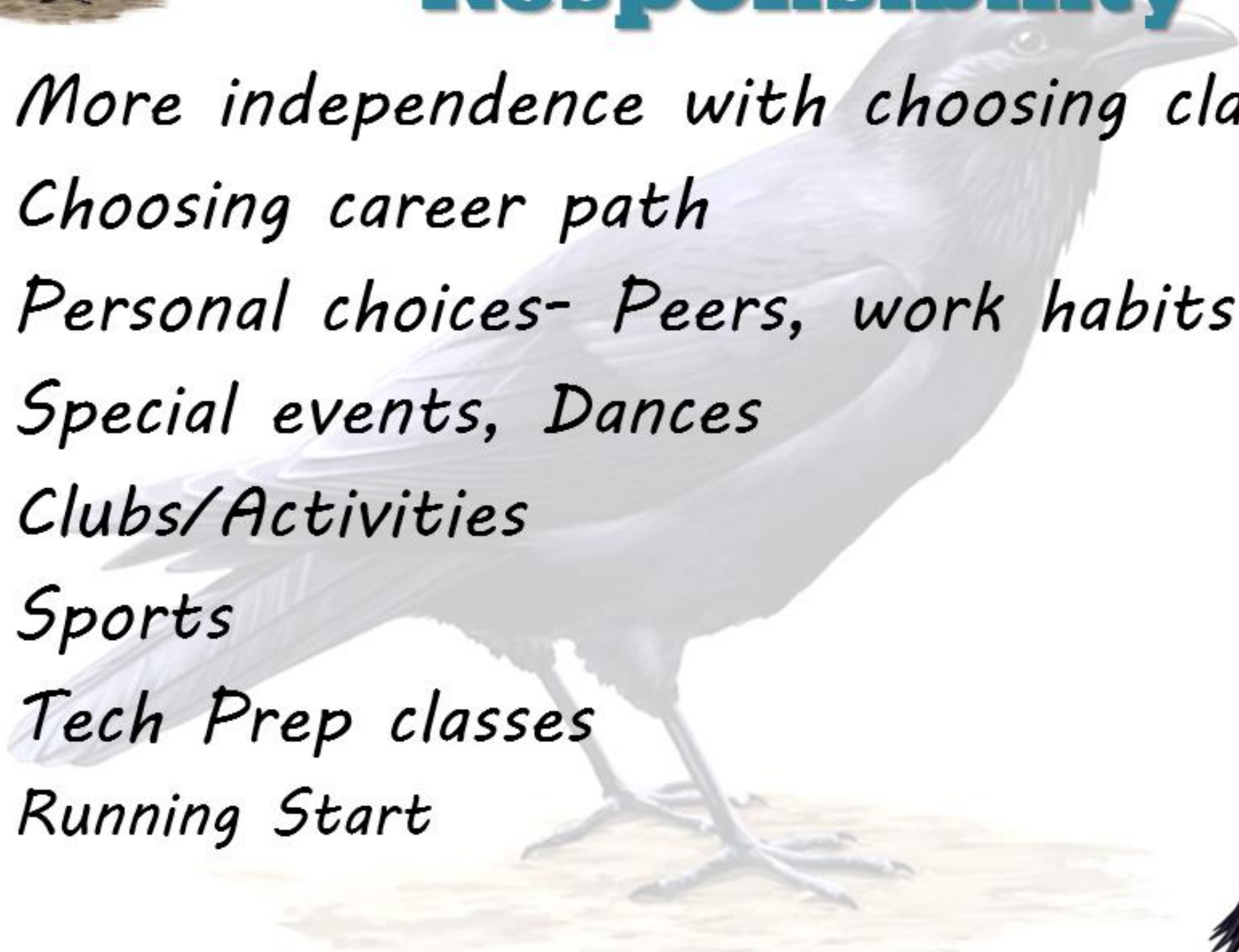
- **Take the most rigorous classes you can (it looks good to colleges when you challenge yourself)**

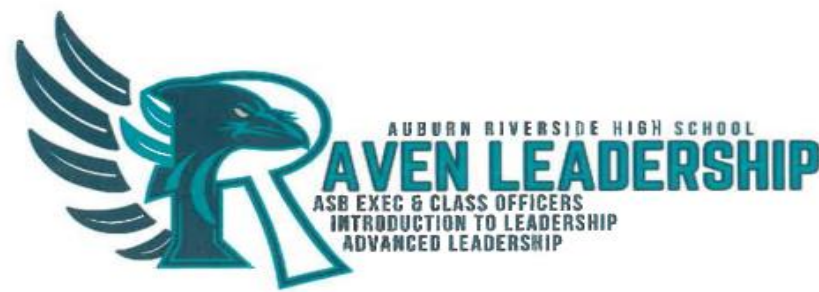
