STUDENT BIOGRAPHY WRITING SECTION

Please respond to the following prompts. Type and print your responses on another sheet of paper and staple them to this form. You may use more than one sheet of paper.

Prompt 1 (Short Answer):

Choose any three of the following five prompts. Use 100-150 words for each question. Provide a word count for each answer.

1. Knowledge or creativity in a field:

Describe any of your special interests and how you have developed knowledge in these areas. Give examples of your creativity: the ability to see alternatives; take diverse perspectives; come up with many, varied, or original ideas; or willingness to try new things.

2. Dealing with adversity:

Describe the most significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to address this challenge. Include whether you turned to anyone in facing that challenge, the role that person played, and what you learned about yourself.

3. Community service:

Explain what you have done to make your community a better place to live. Give examples of specific projects in which you have been involved over time.

4. Handling systemic challenges:

Describe your experiences facing or witnessing discrimination. Tell us how you responded, what you learned from those experiences, and how they have prepared you to contribute to the university community.

5. Goals/task commitment:

Articulate the goals you have established for yourself and your efforts to accomplish these. Give at least one specific example that demonstrates your work ethic/diligence.

PROMPT 2 (Personal Statement):

Describe an achievement, significant experience, or challenge that conveys to the reader a sense of who you are.

Suggested length: 1-3 pages, double-spaced, typed, 12 point font
