Grade 3: May 14, 15, 16, 17, 22, 23, 24 Grade 4: May 14, 15, 16, 17, 22, 23, 24 Grade 4-5 split: May 8, 9, 10, 22, 23, 24, Grade 5: May 8, 9, 10, 22, 23, 24, 25; June 1

Please avoid scheduling anything that will take your child out of school on the days he or she is testing. Third-fifth grade students should have brought home a letter with more details about what tests will be on which days and other information. Please let us know if you didn't receive this letter.

Welcome to Kindergarten

If you have a child who will start kindergarten next year, please plan to attend our "Welcome to Kindergarten" event on Tuesday, May 8th from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. and kindergarten assessment screening on Wednesday, May 16th sometime during the school day. If you register at one school and then move, you can change your registration to your new school. Please share this information with anyone else you know who will have a kindergartener next year.
