- Create a presentation that is visually pleasing and interesting. Keep words on the slides to a minimum. You want the audience listening to you, not reading a slide.
- Practice your presentation.
- Look at and speak to your audience.
- > Ask your advisor for guidance if needed.

Don'ts

- Procrastinate.
- > Use the same presentation as you used in ninth grade.
- Show slides that are difficult to read.
- Be nervous. This is your story; we all want to hear it.
