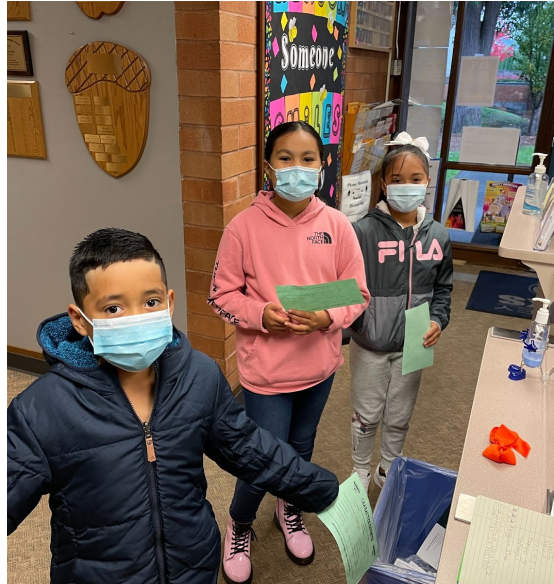

HIGHLY CAPABLE

ASD is now accepting referrals for the 2022-2023 Highly Capable Program, a program that serves exceptionally intelligent, intellectually gifted students whose needs may not be easily met in the general education setting. Once a student is identified as highly capable, he/she is entitled to Highly Capable program services from the date of eligibility through graduation, annual testing is not required. Nomination close Feb 18, 2022.

Screening considers nominees who are currently enrolled in grades Kindergarten through eleven. Selection for highly capable programs reflect state guidelines for identifying intellectually gifted students. If you feel your child should participate in further testing, but doesn't meet screening criteria, you may nominate your child. Nomination forms are in school counseling offices and are available online by selection from For Families menu, Highly Capable, and then Highly Capable Forms.
