

Right At School Before and After School Childcare

- Right At School is an organization that partners with the Auburn School District to provide before school and after school childcare at Lake View.

Lake View Health Room

- All health conditions should be reported to the nurse so that we can update your student's school health record.
 - A Health Care Plan or Emergency Action Plan will be created if indicated. This must be signed every year.
- Medications at school
 - All meds (even over the counter) require a <u>Medication Authorization Form</u> signed by a healthcare provider and parent every year.
 - Medication must be brought to the health room with original packaging/label.
 - Recommend a 3 day supply in case of an emergency.
- All immunizations must be up to date before students can start class OR an
 exemption must be signed by doctor and brought in to the main office. This is in
 accordance with Washington State Law.


