Auburn School District is committed to improving student learning. One of our strategies for this improvement includes having teachers work collaboratively in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs), or small teaching groups, to ensure this continuous improvement.

Teachers working in professional learning communities:

- Align curriculum with the state standards for each course and grade . level
- Examine students work
- Create common assessments or tests
- Analyze students' testing data to determine goals to improve each • student's learning
- Identify students that need additional time and support to meet standard or move beyond the standards

Our schools are excited and dedicated to improving student learning through PLCs. The past eight years have shown all of us how effective these times can be and the Auburn School District is committed to continue having PLC designated Mondays with 60 minute "late starts."
