### Plans for 2021-22 School Year

The Auburn School District is planning for full-time in-person instruction for the 21-22 school year. We believe in-person learning provides the greatest opportunity for academic success and social emotional well-being for most students. We anticipate masks will still be required in the fall and some other health and safety requirements. We will continue to follow the Washington State Department of Health guidelines and will communicate decisions as soon as they are made.

Some families may have unique health concerns and some may prefer an online learning model based on their student’s success this year. To gather information about meeting the needs of our community, we are asking all families to complete a Program Interest Survey. We want to understand the reasons behind family choices and plan for next year.

If there is sufficient interest and enrollment, we will offer Auburn Online, a new virtual school option during the 21-22 school year for students entering kindergarten through 12th grade.

**If you haven’t already, you will receive an email very soon with a survey link specific to each of your students. Please complete the survey for each student—this determines school staffing for the upcoming school year.**

*Lakeland Hills Elementary will be full-time, in-person for the 2021-22 school year. If you need to select the Auburn Online option, this will be its own entity and not part of Lakeland Hills Elementary.*





**Vaccine Options:**

**Pfizer for ages 12 and older (First of 2 doses)**

**Johnson & Johnson for ages 18 and older (1 dose only)**

**Pfizer & Moderna second doses**

**You will be scheduled for your second vaccine appointment, for 2 shot series, at the time of your first vaccination. Second doses will be administered on June 12.**

Once registered, each participant will need to fill out a consent form. A parent or guardian must sign the consent form for any student under age 18. Additionally, a parent or guardian must be present at the clinic with students age 12-15 receiving a vaccine. Students age 16 & 17 do not require a parent/guardian to be present.

ECEAP (Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program) is a **free** early learning program that provides many services to eligible children and their families.

## *Who is Eligible?*

- Children age 3 - 5 years (must be 3 or 4 years old by August 31)
- Children in Foster Care/Kinship Care/Adopted
- Children with an IEP
- Families living on low incomes (based on federal poverty guidelines)
