Important Health Information

Parents/Care Givers:

Please make sure you keep your kids home and call the office if they have any of these Covid-19 symptoms:

• Fever (equal to or above 100.4 degrees) or Chills. Students need to be fever-free for 24 hours WITHOUT the use of any fever reducing medication before returning to school

- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Cough (new, changed, or worsening)

Students should also stay home if they have any of the symptoms listed below. If they have only one symptom, they have not been in close contact with someone with Covid, they've had no fever for 24 hours (without taking medication), no additional symptoms develop, and symptoms have improved dramatically they can come back to school:

- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
