To the Parents of Students Interested In Safety Patrol:

As you have come to school you have probably seen adults and students serving on our school Safety Patrol. It is now time to add a few new members so that we have a full crew during play practice and when the 5th graders go to camp. Safety Patrol members must be responsible students, that are at least 10 years old, to participate in this leadership opportunity at Lakeland Hills.

Students must be able to commit to their assignment and be on time. They will need to arrive in the morning at 8:00 am (9:00 on late-start Monday) or after school stay approximately 25 minutes to cross all students and families and bring gear back in. Students are assigned to the schedule based on their availability with an average of two shifts per week. Schedules come out about every 4 weeks so that changes can be made to the schedule as student commitments change. We wear a bright orange/yellow vest and hard-hat and use a crossing flag. Rain jackets are available and we have hi visibility gloves for cold weather. In addition, it is a good idea to wear boots on rainy days or bring a pair of dry shoes to change into after patrol.

If you feel your child would excel at this opportunity, please fill out the bottom of this form and the attached permission slip and return it to me in the library. I will set up a time for them to come back in during recess to watch the training video and go over safety procedures and expectations. Please give me an idea of their availability. I will schedule them to go out with me to train at the corner and work them into the schedule as soon as I can. Being a crossing guard is a great opportunity for your child to learn, practice and demonstrate leadership skills. If you have any questions, please feel free to email me at clee@auburn.wednet.edu.
