Hearing and Vision Screening Information



Washington State law (WAC 246-760) requires schools to conduct auditory and visual screenings of children each year. **Students in grades K, 1, 2, 3, and 5 are screened.** Students are also screened at the guardian or teachers requests. If your child is not scheduled for screening this year you may request a screening by contacting your child's teacher or school nurse. Inform them of any concerns you may have.

Our all-screening day is Friday, October 4th. Screening is completed by the Auburn School District Screening Team, led by the school nurse. **Vision screening** for near and distance vision will be done using the SPOT (photorefractor). Students who wear corrective lenses are screened with the lenses on. Parents are informed by mail if their child does not pass the screening.

Hearing screening is done using equipment providing tonal stimuli at 1000, 2000 and 4000 hertz (Hz) at hearing levels of 20 decibels (dB). Students who do not pass the initial hearing test are then scheduled to be re-screened. Parent/guardians are notified by mail if their child does not pass the second screening.

A professional evaluation by a physician is recommended for students who do not pass their vision or hearing screenings. If you have any questions regarding the results of your child's screening, or if for some reason, you do not wish your child screened for either hearing or vision, **please contact Vicki Wagner at 253-876-7711**

18 OR MORE DAYS

- Excused and unexcused absences represent lost time in the classroom and lost opportunities to learn.
- Missing just one day every two weeks can add up to 18 days in a year. Absences add up before you even know it.



10 TO 17 DAYS

- Students who are absent an average of 15 days a year miss a year's worth of school before their senior year.
- When students miss a day of school it actually puts them two days behind their classmates.



9 OR FEWER ABSENCES

- Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more.
- Children benefit and make the most of their educational opportunities if they attend school regularly and on time.



On **Thursday, October 17th**, from 1:30-2:30 PM, we will be conducting a large scale earthquake drill at Lakeland Hills. During this time, phones will not be answered since our office staff will be participating in the drill. If you need to pick your child up from school during this time, you may do so. We ask you to check your child out at our reunification tables, which will be located in the parking lot next to the gym. When we drill, we are not only preparing for an earthquake, we are preparing for any disaster.

Parent volunteers are needed to help us walk through the reunification process (reuniting students with their families). **If you would like to participate, please email Mrs. Barlow or stop by her office** and she will give you further instructions. Your participation in the drill will allow you to learn the emergency procedures we have in place.

Thank you for your help and cooperation as we attempt to become more skilled at enhancing the level of your child's safety while at school. As always, Mrs. Barlow appreciates hearing your questions or concerns.
