What are School-Based Prevention and Intervention Specialists?

The School-Based Prevention and Intervention Specialist Team is made up of three Prevention and Intervention Specialists and one Coordinator. This team provides one-on-one and/or group counseling to students who are currently using or have used substances or are affected by other individuals use such as family members or friends. On top of providing counseling this team teaches a LifeSkills Curriculum to 6th and 9th graders which is a “substance abuse prevention program proven to reduce the risk of alcohol, drug abuse, and violence by targeting the major social and psychological factors that promote the initiation of substance use and other risky behaviors”. This team also specializes in presentation for students, staff, parents, and the community.
