## i-READY

### WHAT IS IT?

### WHY SHOULD MY CHILD DO IT?

I-Ready is an on-line instructional program for Reading and Math. Student completed an assessment in September and lessons are assigned to students based on their skill needs.

i-Ready provides "just right" lessons to support students in their areas of greatest need.

READING provides lessons in:

**Phonological Awareness** - Phonological awareness is an umbrella term that encompasses both basic levels of awareness of speech sounds

**Phonics** - teaches the relationships between the letters of written language and the sounds of spoken language

**High Frequency Words** — Sight words

**Vocabulary** — knowing the meaning of words to be able to communicate effectively – 4 types of vocabulary – speaking, listening, reading and writing.

**Comprehension Literature** — to understand and be able to use the information from what is being read in fiction.

**Comprehension Informational Text** - to understand and be able to use the information from what is being read in non-fiction.

MATH provides lessons in:

**Numbers and Operations** — Understand numbers, how to complete operations with +, -, /, x.

**Algebra and Algebraic Thinking** – seeing patterns, solving equations, mathematical thinking

**Measurement and Data** — understand the types of measurements, using information to solve problems

**Geometry** — study of the sizes, shapes, positions of angles and dimensions of things.

# Library Checkout

## Grades 3, 4, 5

Students can check out books from our library in 4 easy steps:

1. Parent completes the [Check-out Form](#) – highlight the words Check-out Form and you may need to right click and open hyperlink
2. Then the student logs into their DESTINY account
3. Student places HOLDS on up to 5 books
4. Student picks up books on Tuesday or Thursday between 11:10 and 12:40 by the lunch area in the back of the building.

How do I put books on hold in Destiny Discover?

1. Go to the Hazelwood Destiny Discover website - <https://search.follettsoftware.com/metasearch/ui/11063>
2. Click on **Catalog** at the top, then **Destiny Discover** on the left side, then **Log In** at the top right.
3. **Sign in with Google.**
4. Search for a topic you are interested in. Filter by AR level. Select a book and click 'hold.' Place holds on up to five books. You will be notified by email when your books are ready for pickup. If your books are not picked up within one week, they will be put back on the shelf and available for others. Remember that pick up is on Tuesday and Thursday between 11:10 and 12:40 near the lunch pickup area.
