PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Dick Scobee Elementary, formally known as North Auburn Elementary School was originally built in 1954. The Dick Scobee Elementary School Replacement Project will replace the existing school and include general and specialist's classrooms, administration offices, a gymnasium, a library, a kitchen and a covered play area. Improvements to the nine-acre site will include a playground, a turf playing field, enhanced student pick-up and drop-off areas in addition to a bus loading area. Construction activities for the Dick Scobee Elementary School Replacement Project are scheduled to begin July 1st, 2019 with a substantial completion date of July 31st, 2020.
