11 12	The HSBP period is solely for the facilitation of the High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP) as required by state law.		
13	b. Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Period		
14 15	The SEL period is for the implementation of district approved curriculum/activities to improve students social emotional and behavioral development.		
16 17	c. Intervention-Enrichment Period		
18 19 20	The intervention-enrichment period is for the purposes of assisting student success in academic classes (including grade checks) or facilitating clubs/activities.		
21 22	d. State and ASD Requirements		
23 24 25 26 27 28 29	8 th period may also be used for state and Auburn School District requirements such as: i. Digital citizenship ii. Rules and regulations iii. HIV iv. Bullying and harassment v. Scheduling vi. Occasional School Assembly Recognition		
30 31	Instruction about bullet points i-iv. shall occur within the first four weeks of the year. Instruction around bullet points v-vi. shall be occasional in nature.		
32	Flex Time		

8th period should have minimal requirements for work beyond the contracted day. If work beyond

the contracted day is necessary for the preparation of 8th period, teachers may flex up to thirty (30)

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35 36	minutes of Before and After School time time should be communicated with the b	e per quarter. The desire to flex Before and After School pullding supervisor.

38 39 40 41	There should be no required grading outside of the 8 th period time frame. Any grading shall be limited to the HSBP requirements only and shall be P/NC only. For quarters 1-3, grades are only required to be updated once per quarter and at the end of the quarter. During the 4 th quarter, grades shall be updated at the mid-term and the end of the quarter.		
42	Lost planning time		
43 44	Staff who lose 4 (four) minutes of planning time due to 8 th period will not be required to allow students into their classroom until one (1) minute prior to the end of passing period.
