Checklist for Dance Ticket Purchase

- Watch Video. Sign Dance Waiver
- Turn in to Debbie Sumner in the bookkeeper's office for approval to purchase tickets. If you DO have a guest that is not an Auburn High School student, keep going...
- Guest must watch the video and signs the Dance Waiver
- Complete the Guest Pass if you are bringing a guest, including clear and visible photo ID.
- Turn in to Diana Ramirez Perez in the Activities Office for approval to purchase tickets.

In order to promote a healthy, safe, and enjoyable evening for all students in a style that is appropriate for a schoolhouse, the following procedures will be in place for AHS dances.

This Dance Contract will only need to be submitted once; however, it must be filled out completely. Incomplete forms or forms suspected of being forged will NOT be accepted.

Understand that these dances are school related events, and all school rules apply. I agree to abide by the dance behavior rules set forth in this contract including rules on tobacco, drugs, alcohol, language, and behavior. I agree to follow the dance guidelines for the duration of the dance.

DANCE GUIDELINES: (Applies on and off the dance floor) Lewd and lascivious dancing such as "grinding" will result in a verbal warning. Second violation will result in student being asked to leave and may make them ineligible to attend future dance. Dancing guidelines include, but are not limited to:

- No straddling legs
- No bending over
- Face others when dancing as couples or in groups
- No grind, twerk, or freak dancing
- All contact must be appropriate for a public-school event
- No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public display of affection)
- Keep hands off the ground
- Chaperones need to be able to walk through the dance floor while students and guests are dancing.

Dress Code Requirements: Although formal dress differs from general school wear, school appropriateness is still required. Always follow the Dress Code as outlined in the Student/Parent Handbook. Clothing that is gang related, deemed unacceptable by Administrators, or generally disruptive, is prohibited. If you are unsure of your attire or if it meets code requirements, please check with the Activities Coordinators, Ms. Graves or Ms. Jensen prior to the day of the event.

All students must present a current AHS student identification card or other form of ID at the registration table at the dance. **If you fail to bring identification with you, then you will not be allowed into the dance.

Students with non-AHS guests: Dance guest forms must be turned in by the Wednesday at 3:00pm before the event and it is expected that your guest is informed of the rules (including dress code) and adheres to them as your guest for the evening. Guests must also sign this contract.

- GUESTS MUST BE 9TH grade minimum and no older than 20. Students are allowed ONE guest, no exceptions. Guests must arrive with their AHS host student. Guests who violate the dance contract MAY not be allowed to any future dances during the current school year.
- Guests will also need to have photo ID in order to attend the event.
