



Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are thrilled to be welcoming back our student athletes this year! Thank you for all that you do to continue to support them during this unusual time. We are working hard to communicate all changes and updates as quickly as they happen and are working to make the best possible decisions for the safety of our students and community. This communication is to share with you how limited transportation will affect athletic competitions.

As our district continues to move forward with the return to in-person learning and high school athletics, we are working closely with our transportation department to be able to offer transportation to as many games and competitions as we can. When District transportation is not available, it will be the parent/guardians' sole responsibility to arrange transportation to and from games or competitions.

At this time, we will do everything we can to provide district transportation for contests prior to 6:00 pm, but if district transportation is not available, parents/guardians will have to make transportation arrangements for athletic/activity events that start prior to 6:00 pm. District staff will only be able to provide specific directions to the destination, meeting locations at the site and the times students must arrive and be picked up. School district staff will not be able to arrange or assist with transportation at any time. It is up to you as the parent/guardian to decide to allow your student to drive himself or herself or if you decide to arrange a carpool with your neighbors.
