COVID UPDATES

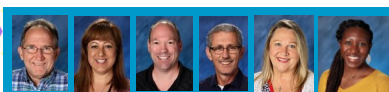
With the rise in cases in Washington state, please discuss the importance of wearing a mask at school to keep everyone safe.
