AR TIME: INTERVENTION/ENRICHMENT

Mid-term 1 grades were posted on **Oct. 6**. From these grades, students are assigned the opportunity for **Intervention** or **Enrichment**. Intervention and Enrichment classes take place during 8th period, which happens in between periods 3 and 4. **This Intervention/Enrichment period is called AR Time and is 30 minutes long.** Intervention assignments are given for students struggling in classes and/or having a failing grade. We also schedule intervention for all D and D+ grades as far as we can facilitate them and keep intervention classes at a cap of 20 students. Students who are passing all their classes with a C- or better will have access to many resources and activities. Attendance is taken and students are expected to attend Intervention or Enrichment for the 30-minute period. Students and parents will be notified of an Intervention assignment via Family Access and email. Students remain in their assignment until our next grading period on Nov. 12. **Intervention/Enrichment will begin on Oct. 14.**

COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID HOT TOPICS

College Financial Aid Hot Topic: **FAFSA Application**. Information provided on the FAFSA is only used to determine a student's eligibility for financial aid. While completing the FAFSA does not obligate a student or a parent to accept financial aid, it is required in most cases to be eligible for grants, scholarships, or work study assistance. Completing the FAFSA typically takes about 30 minutes. You will need to set up a **FAFSA ID** in advance and **have these documents with you** when you sit down to fill out the application. The application is **also available in Spanish**.

College Financial Aid Hot Topic: **Who is my "Parent" when I fill out the FAFSA?** Figuring out how to complete the FAFSA can be complicated. Families are often confused about how to provide parent information when applying. Click the link for help on how to answer questions on this topic.
