What's Happening At Olympic Middle School?



Construction of a new Olympic Middle School will soon be underway! The new school will replace the old buildings and will be constructed here on the same campus. Once construction of the new school is complete, the existing building will undergo improvements to allow it to function as an interim elementary school, housing students from Dick Scobee, Pioneer, Chinook and Terminal Park Elementary Schools over the next few years as their schools are modernized.

The new school was designed by BLRB Architects, and Absher Construction Company is the general contractor/construction manager. The new school is anticipated to be approximately 98,000 square feet in size and will accommodate 800 students in grades 6-8. The building will be two stories and will include general classrooms, specialty classrooms such as art, CTE/STEM, music, science and special education, gymnasiums, and commons support spaces.

The Olympic Middle School campus will also undergo improvements to student pick-up and drop-off areas; bus loading and unloading areas; staff, visitor and event parking; and exterior courtyard and delivery areas.



Construction Safety Tips For The Community



The safety of the surrounding community is Absher's number one priority on each of our jobsites. We are taking every precaution to ensure a safe project, and ask for your assistance in maintaining a safe project site. Below are safety tips to remember throughout the construction process. Please discuss these with your children, as well.

- Travel with caution and slow down when in construction zones. Be alert for construction workers and heavy equipment, as well as cyclists, pedestrians, and other traffic.
- Allow plenty of time for traveling around the site, in case of driving delays.
- Follow posted signs that explain detours, lane closures and other changes in driving conditions. Remember that traffic fines are doubled in construction areas.
- Do not enter active construction areas or areas that are secured with safety boarding and/or fencing.
- Do not distract onsite construction workers.
- Use extra caution in the evenings when it is dark or during rainy weather.
- Be patient. Remember that construction is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term benefit.
