ATTENTION HYBRID FAMILIES

- **1. COVID-19 Acknowledgment Form.** This form is available now on Family Access. This form is required to be completed prior to your students first day back in the building (March 3rd PK-2nd and March 15th 3rd-5th). Once you are logged in to Family Access click on "Online Forms," select "COVID-19 Acknowledgment" then select "fill out form." Please visit Family Access now to complete this form.
- **2. Daily Wellness Screening.** This quick 2-question screening must be completed <u>each</u> <u>day</u> before 8:30am that your child is in the building before they come to school. This will begin on March 3rd for PK-2nd and March 15th 3rd-5th. Please watch the <u>this video</u> with instructions on how to complete this screening.
