FINAL:

Semester Final assessment, project, presentation, report, analysis, discussions, project or problem based assignments will have weight to help improve a student's current measurement of learning. There needs to be a reason for students doing their best.

CLASS:

For classes that have already had their final, be sure to offer activities aligned to course standards or frameworks. If a movie is used, it needs to be aligned with course standards and there needs to be a way for students to improve their learning (and subsequently their grade). We have plenty of students at AHS who could use this time to get in late work or to retake quizzes/tests per your classroom policy & practice.
