Purchase of ASB Cards, Chromebook Insurance, and Yearbooks can be purchased on Cougar Day or online beginning August 22. Avoid long lines by purchasing items online. Yearbooks are only available for a limited time (see time-line below).

**Lost Books**: If you have located lost books, please bring them with you on Cougar Day

<u>Fines/Fees</u>: All fines and previous fees must be paid before you are eligible to receive a class schedule <u>ASB Card</u>: You may purchase a student ASB card for \$15.00. All ASB officers, athletes, students involved in clubs, band, orchestra, and choir are required to purchase an ASB card.

<u>Chromebook Maintenance Fee</u>: All students are <u>required</u> to purchase Chromebook Maintenance for \$5. This can be done online or on Cougar Day.

<u>Yearbook</u>: Available for purchase online August 22 thru 25, Cougar Day or in the ASB office September 5 thru September 15—Cost: \$30

\*\*\* Checks for fines and/or fees, Chromebook maintenance fee, ASB card and Yearbook should be made out to Olympic Middle School. Please keep your receipt or cancelled check as proof of purchase. \*\*\*

#### IMMUNIZATIONS: Students must be up—to-date on their immunizations:

- ◆ **Tetanus, Diptheria, and Pertussis**: **5 doses** (4 doses only if 4th dose given on or after 4th birthday) plus **1 dose Tdap** is required for students entering 7th grade.
- Varicella (Chickenpox): 2 doses or healthcare provider verification of the disease
- ♦ IPV,OPV (Polio): 4 doses (3 doses only IF 3rd dose given on or after 4th birthday)
- ♦ Measles, Mumps, Rubella: 2 doses
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses, dose 3 must be given on or after 24 weeks of age

If your child has not been immunized for any of the above vaccines, please contact your health care provider to make an appointment for your child to receive these vaccines.

We are not able to give schedules to those students who have not met this requirement.

#### Supplies are being provided by the Auburn School District

Individual teachers or teams may request additional supplies in letters sent home at the beginning of the school year or during the year for upcoming activities.



#### P.E. Clothing

Shorts, yoga pants or Sweats, T-Shirt, hoodie, and tennis shoes with laces are required to dress out for P.E. class.

# Would you like to pay for Chromebook Maintenance Fee, ASB Card or a Yearbook online?







Log on to the Olympic Homepage and click on the quick link **Pay for School and/or District Fees and Services**. This will link you to an online payment site. If you already know your login information or have previously created a guest account you can use the user name and password to log in now at

#### Pay Online Instructions for Parents/Guardians:

By signing in this way, you will be able to make online purchases. You will also be able to view past transactions and take care of any fines assessed to your student's account. Please note that you will be charged a convenience fee for most items should you choose to purchase/pay for them online. The fee is 2.5% plus .67 and helps the District cover the costs of offering this payment option.

You will need your Family Access log in ID AND your password.

Log in at <a href="https://wa-auburn.intouchreceipting.com/">https://wa-auburn.intouchreceipting.com/</a>. Enter your User Name (Family Access Log in ID) and Password then click "Sign in."

Next, click on your student's name to see their account information on the right hand side of the next screen. You can also click on the "products available to" link and be taken to your student's school site to see what is available to purchase.

You can purchase items from multiple sites for different students in the same transaction.

#### **Pay Online Instructions for Guests:**

By signing in with a guest account, you can see the receipt history for your past purchases paid for online. You can pay for a variety of items that have been made available to guests at each site.

#### If this is your first time using our payment website, you will need to:

- Click on the "For guests (other than parents) sign up here" link. You will need to fill in all the boxes and then click "Sign up"
- Then you can enter your User Name and Password then click Sign in
- You can view past purchases at the right or click on the Shop button to visit the store
- Next you can choose from the different locations via the location links
- To pay for something for a location other than a School, you will need to click on Admin Building, then District Office and choose a location, then select the items you wish to purchase
- You can purchase items from multiple sites in the same transaction

Before you can attend the first practice you must get your file up to date in the ASB office with Mrs. Mu'min. This includes a physical, parent permission, insurance information, a concussion form, a cardiac arrest form, a code of conduct form (all forms are in Skyward), and the purchase of an ASB card. The athletic physical is good for two years so if you turned in an athletic physical form last year, you only need to do the concussion form, code of conduct form, cardiac arrest form, and purchase an ASB card. **8**<sup>th</sup> **grade athletes will need a new physical if they had their physical in 6**<sup>th</sup> **grade**. Athletic Packets are available in Skyward for both parent/student.

### To participate in all sports, parents/athletes must fill out all appropriate paperwork in Skyward Family Access:

- <u>Athletic Participation Form</u> with physical examination dated **after July 1, 2022.** Available on the Auburn School District webpage, in the ASB Office or from your physicians office. *Physical Examinations/Athletic Registration forms are valid for two consecutive years.*
- WIAA Concussion Information Sheet
- ASD Athletic Code and Rules
- WIAA Cardiac Arrest Awareness Form
- A current ASB card (\$15.00)
- <u>Clearance</u>—All athletes must be cleared through the ASB office.
- <u>School insurance or private insurance</u> on file in the school main office. Insurance is mandatory to be eligible (must have group # on Athletic Participation form). Forms for student accident insurance are available on the Auburn School District website.

#### **Student Insurance**

The Auburn School District does not provide medical insurance coverage for school accidents. This means parents are responsible for medical bills if a student is hurt during school activities. The district does provide information about a student accident health insurance plan, although this plan is not recommended over any other plan as many options are available. The plan is made available to parents for their consideration. Any questions regarding the plan, need to be directed to the company listed on the brochure.

## What is an ASB card? What benefits does it provide?

All students at Olympic will receive an ID card. The photograph that is taken on picture day will be mounted on this card. All ASB officers, athletes, students involved in clubs, robotics, band, orchestra, choir, and drama are required to purchase an ASB sticker for their card. The money from the sale of ASB stickers goes to help support activities for our students. Students presenting an ID card with an ASB sticker at school events normally pay a lower ticket price. There is a \$5.00 charge for a replacement card.

## OLYMPIC MIDDLE SCHOOL FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL CHANGES

So we can best support our incoming 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and make their transition to middle school the best it can be, we've made changes to what the first day of school looks like.

#### 6<sup>th</sup> grade schedule for the first day (Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>)

#### 7:40am - 2:10pm

The first day will be 6<sup>th</sup> graders only for the first half of the day. This will give us a chance to really help them to get acquainted with our procedures, routines, etc. Buses will run at their normal morning times, school breakfast and lunch will be served, bell schedule for the day will be adjusted. LOTS of support will be provided to our 6<sup>th</sup> graders.

#### 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade schedule for the first day (Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>)

#### 11:40am - 2:10pm

7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will report to school 4 hours late (they will begin school at 11:40 that day). Buses will run for the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> graders to get to school but 4 hours later than normal (i.e. if they would normally catch the AM bus at 6:45am on the first day, it will come 4 hours later at 10:45am) *No breakfast or lunch will be served for 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> graders*. They will attend <u>all</u> of their classes on a modified schedule in the afternoon so they can meet all teachers and see where all their classes are located. Attendance will be taken and this will count as a regular day of school.

We will be working hard with ALL of our students to orient them to middle school. We will be working hard to engage/re-engage/train them on all the routines and such of our great school. It will be the priority of the start of our school year!

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#### Reminder of daily before school times/routines

After the first day of school, the routine for the morning time at Olympic is:

7:15am – those having school breakfast may enter the commons to eat. ONLY those students eating breakfast may enter at this time.

7:25am – bell rings to allow students in the building. No students inside the building before this time.

7:35am – 5 minute warning bell rings, start heading to first period.

7:40am - first period begins. ALL STUDENTS MUST BE IN THEIR SEAT AT THIS TIME!!!!
