

Auburn School District Replacement Levy on February 13 Ballot

The Auburn School District Board of Directors unanimously approved placing a four-year Educational Programs and Operations (EP&O) Replacement Levy on the February 13 ballot.

The EP&O levy replaces the 2020 levy that expires in 2024 and provides 14% of the ASD budget. Funds from the levy are used for: all athletics and activities; family engagement staff and activities; special education programs and transportation; staffing underfunded by the state including nurses, security officers, school resource officers, psychologists and library staff; maintenance, transportation and extended learning opportunities.

The district will collect no more than \$2.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation in each of the levy years. The levy will collect \$51.8 million in 2025; \$54.4 million in 2026; \$57.1 million in 2027 and \$60 million in 2028. The total tax rate will not increase.
