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

Parent Technology Agreement Forms

Due to changes with Google's Terms of Service, parents have been prompted to sign a Technology Agreement form. This form is available on Skyward Family Access and provides consent for students to use Google Additional Services and any ASD-approved tool that requires permission for under-13s or under-18s.

- Parents fill out this form by logging into their Skyward account. Parents should have received an email notification about this new process back at the start of the school year.

Change in Immunization Recordkeeping

Dear Families,

The Auburn School District is changing how we manage student immunization records. We are now using the School Module, an online system provided by the Washington State Department of Health.



The School Module allows us to quickly and efficiently check if your child has the vaccines required for school. This will save us time on finding and entering vaccination dates and free up time to work with students. As most health care providers also use this system, it will also save parents time. It will allow your school nurse to quickly verify immunizations without you having to provide new records.


Most children born and/or vaccinated in Washington already have their information in the system. You can access your child's record at any time by signing up for MyIR at https://wa.myir.net/register.

As we move to this system, the school nurse may ask you for more information about your child's vaccination history. If your child is missing vaccines in the system, we may ask for a copy of their immunization record. We may also send home a copy of their Certificate of Immunization for your signature. This grants us permission to keep their immunization record up to date. We appreciate your patience as we move to this new record keeping system.
