## FLOWN GOODS POLICY

- Flown scenery must be constructed so that it can withstand the forces applied to it when rigged to a batten.
- Flown Scenery must be constructed with proper hardware using proper construction techniques to ensure it will not fall apart. Steel lag screws, bolts, and wood screws are acceptable. Drywall screws and general purpose screws are not acceptable.
- All flown goods must have properly attached rated hardware such as Top or Bottom Hangers, or D rings, C-clamps, or a combination for attachment to battens or aircraft cable.
- Any flown goods must be hung with wire rope or rope that is rated for overhead rigging. The PAC provides a limited amount of Tie Line and 1/8" 7x19 galvanized aircraft cable.
- Hanging anything using Tie Line can not exceed 15 lbs per point.
- Hanging anything using 1/8" 7x19 galvanized aircraft cable can not exceed 285 lbs per point.
- Some of our line sets have a maximum limit of 800 lbs per line set, while some have a 1000 lbs limit per line set.
- Our maximum available counterweight is ~ 3500 lbs.
- Approximate weight of flown goods must be provided within +/- 15 lbs.
- If your flown goods do not meet these requirements they will not be flown.
