


## **Technology Replacement Levy Proposition 2**

The Board of Directors has set a \$35,000,000 technology replacement levy for Tuesday, February 11, 2020. The technology levy is a six-year levy and replaces the expiring 2014 technology levy. It provides funding to implement recommendations from the 2019 Technology Citizens Ad Hoc Committee.

The 29-member committee of community members, parents, teachers and staff met during the spring and summer to review the 2014 Technology Levy accomplishments and the status of ASD's current technology infrastructure. The committee defined the purpose of the Technology Replacement levy is to enable students to be successful and competitive in a globally connected society, emphasizing digital citizenship and 21st-century skills.



## The Technology Replacement Levy provides a stable tax rate.
