

The Auburn School District Board of Directors has set an Educational Program and Operations replacement levy for Tuesday, February 11, 2020. The levy is a four-year levy and replaces the expiring 2016 Educational Program and Operations levy. It provides funding for educational programs, special education, family engagement, career and college readiness, enhanced staffing, extended learning opportunities and all athletics and activities.

The levy provides staffing not fully funded by the state:
