

The Auburn School District Board of Directors has set an Educational Programs and Operations replacement levy for **Tuesday, February 13, 2024**. The levy is a four-year levy and replaces the expiring 2020 Educational Programs and Operations levy. It provides funding for educational programs, special education, family engagement, extra staffing for positions underfunded by the state, extended learning opportunities and all athletics and activities.

The levy provides staffing not fully funded by the state:
