Counties, municipal corporations, and special purpose districts are to periodically redistrict its governmental unit based upon population information from the most recent federal decennial census.

Redistricting Criteria

Applied in the order shown.

- Nearly equal in population as possible
- Be as compact as possible
- Consist of geographically contiguous area
- Population data may not be used for purposes of favoring or disfavoring any racial group or political party
- To the extent feasible and if not inconsistent with the basic enabling legislation...district boundaries shall coincide with existing recognized natural boundaries and shall, to the extent possible, preserve existing communities of related and mutual interest
- Other criteria the Board would like to be considered
