RESOLUTION NO. 1198 OPPOSING THE CLOSURE OF THE KING COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH CLINIC IN AUBURN

WHEREAS, the Auburn School District is one of the largest districts in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Auburn School District has 22 schools, encompasses a 62-mile area bridging King and Pierce counties, and serves approximately 15,000 students and 70,500 residents in Auburn, Algona, Pacific, Lake Tapps and unincorporated areas of King County; and

WHEREAS, the Auburn School District and the community share a strong concern for the disadvantaged members of the community, particularly families with children; and

WHEREAS, the Auburn clinic closure will eliminate necessary services for thousands of low-income clients, primarily women, that are critical to reducing poverty, supporting maternal and infant health, and providing family nutrition; and

WHEREAS, research has shown that the better nutrition a child has in those very early years lead to better academic success,

WHEREAS, clients of the Auburn clinic are overwhelmingly low income and people of color, with 97% of clients having incomes 200% below the national income level, and 61% being people of color, while 51% do not have medical insurance; and

WHEREAS, South King County will be without disease prevention programs that track and respond to outbreaks of public health threats like tuberculosis, whooping cough and measles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Auburn School District No. 408 Board of Directors opposes the proposal to close the Auburn public health clinic, which would leave the southernmost part of King County without a public health clinic. The Board of Directors firmly believes that any cuts should reflect a commitment to equity across the county's service area and reflect the locations of populations of need.
