HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR SCHOOL

At Cascade, we are working hard to ensure that our Honors program reflects our student demographics. We believe that having an Honors program that reflects the students we teach opens the doors to all students and prepares those students to have greater opportunities beyond high school graduation. We recognize that we still have more work to do and we will continue to make these opportunities happen.

We are currently in year four of our partnership with the YMCA through our CLC grant. This partnership has created numerous after school activities and a summer program for our students. The purpose of this partnership is to create relationships with students outside of the school with the intent of having students feel connected to the school. By accomplishing this, we hope to increase student attendance, decrease student discipline and increase academic performance. This upcoming school year brings some exciting and new opportunities for us as we continue to build our after school program to provide both academic and extra-curricular programs for all of our students.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

For the upcoming school year, we have created Parent University. This will be a series of 4 workshops that will take place throughout the school year to help inform parents on how to stay actively involved in their child's education. We are partnering with GUIDED PATHWAYS to host these workshops.

In addition to parent conferences, Cascade offers our Open House and content nights for parents to attend. The Open House takes place before school starts and allows us to build relationships with our families. The content nights allow parents to be exposed to the curriculum and participate in activities to help them understand the curriculum.

All parents and community members are invited to participate in school activities.

TITLE PROGRAM

Cascade is a school-wide Title I school. This means that all students at Cascade are Title I students! Title I is a federally funded program developed to help schools raise the literacy and math levels of students. Teachers, parents and especially our students benefit from this unique status. As a school-wide Title I school, Cascade is able to offer high quality instruction to ALL children. Cascade students may receive extra support in reading and math. We are working to improve student learning each year through partnership efforts between our staff, parents and students.






MATH - Grades 6, 7 & 8




SCIENCE - Grade 8
