Tis the season to make sure you get the money you need to attend college next year:

- Every year over \$130,000 is awarded to seniors attending public schools in the Auburn School District. Every senior attending Auburn public schools is eligible to apply. <u>One application</u> can make a student eligible for multiple scholarships!
- <u>The WashBoard</u> connects WA students with all types of scholarship providers....for FREE. Whether you will attend in state or out, you save time by entering your profile once and letting them find the scholarship opportunities that fit. The WashBoard.org is spam-free and will never sell your information.
- The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is used to determine eligibility for **financial aid** including grants, loans and work-study. The FAFSA is also used by states, colleges and universities to determine eligibility for their financial aid programs. Go to www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa to file your FAFSA today.
- Eligibility for several WA State financial aid programs has expanded to include students who are ineligible for federal financial aid due to immigration status. Students who meet requirements for the <u>Washington College Grant</u>, <u>the College Bound Scholarship</u>, <u>State Work Study</u>, or <u>Passport Scholarship</u> should complete the <u>free WASFA</u> (Washington Application for State Financial Aid) to apply for state financial aid.
