ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) Test is a timed multi-aptitude test, and is developed and maintained by the Department of Defense. Scores in four critical areas determines whether you're qualified to enlist in the U.S. military. Your scores in the other areas of the ASVAB will determine how qualified you are for certain military occupational specialties and Enlistment Bonuses.

Even if you are not planning to enlist in the military, the ASVAB can be used as a replacement for the state Smarter Balance Test. See Mrs. Veazey for more information. Sign up sheets in the Library.
