On-time Graduation

For a student to be on-track to graduate in four years, they must have completed a minimum **4.5 credits in 9th grade, 10.5 credits in 10th, 16.5 credits in 11th; and the remainder in 12th grade for a total of 22.5.**

College Academic Distribution Requirements (CADR)

You must take at least 15 CADR credits (30 classes) over your 4 year high school career. The subject areas are math, English, science, social science, world languages, and the arts.
